



PRESENTS INDIA'S FIRST AND BIGGEST **HYGIENE OLYMPIAD**

Ranking Criteria

The grading system determines the scores that are later transformed into ranks. When a student meets the ranking criteria, they are eligible to perceive rank.

Dettol Hygiene Olympiad Exams is conducted in both offline and online formats for kids who have registered through their school, as well as in online mode for students who have participated individually. There will be distinct ranking criteria for the offline and online exams.

CRITERIA FOR QUALIFICATION FOR SCHOOL THROUGH REGISTERED OFFLINE EXAM

Students who meet one of the two requirements below will be eligible for winning National Ranks.

1. Class-wise for top 20% of students', due priority to marks scored in exam will be given.
2. If in case of tie the following criteria will be checked –
 - a. Student's grade/percentage in previous class
 - b. Number of correct and wrong answers
 - c. Negative marks for wrong answers
 - d. Neatness marks can be added

If two or more students receive the same grade in any of the following categories, the grades assigned to the questions with internal marking ratios will be added together.

If two or more students receive identical scores across all sections, they will be given the same rank and the scholarship money will be divided among them.

***Schools selecting online exam can refer to the online evaluation criteria.*

RANKING TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR OFFLINE EXAM:

1. ITO is not obligated to reveal specifics about internal marking since it is a private evaluation procedure.
(If internal marks are there)

CRITERIA FOR QUALIFICATION FOR INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS' ONLINE EXAM

Students who meet one of the two criteria below will be eligible for winning National Ranks.

1. Top 20% of the participating students will be considered for ranking.
2. Time taken to complete the exam will be recorded by the system and the submission in shortest time frame will be considered.
3. If in case of tie the following criteria will be checked before allotting ranks–
 - a. Number of attended questions
 - b. Number of incorrect and correct questions
 - c. Negative marking (0.25) will be deducted
 - d. First attempt submission will be given priority
 - e. Images captured during exam
4. The Olympiad organizer provides few questions with internal marking ratios that will be used during evaluation for difficult ties.



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RANKING TERMS & CONDITONS FOR ONLINE EXAM: (Through School / Individually)

1. After completion of the exam, results will be announced in the app with the marks secured. Since, marks/scores are evaluated automatically by the system, no revaluation is done for online exam.
2. Only final ranks will be shown in the result.
3. In case two or more students score the same marks under all the categories above, they will be awarded the same rank & the scholarship amount will be shared among students.
